**InterScience, Inc. technology to provide
warfighters with enhanced situation awareness**

InterScience, Inc., based in the Rensselaer Technology Park announced that the company has received a \$1.75 million contract from the Office of Naval Research to transition the company's patented C-View™ optical technology to provide expeditionary warfighters with enhanced situation awareness while engaging hidden threats. The funding was provided by the Office of the Secretary of Defense under the Quick Reaction Funds for rapid transition. Under the contract, the company will deliver 15 units in several different configurations for initial testing and evaluation. The C-View technology has been under development at InterScience, Inc. by a team led by Michelle Simkulet, the VP for Operations at the company that included Jason Smith, Jiayin Ma, Alex Hulst and Michael Bredderman. The C-View technology has broad applications ranging from medical diagnostics to surveillance and is being actively developed by the company for commercialization. A related application of the technology to provide military vehicles on patrol and convey duty to automatically detect hostile fire is also currently under consideration by DoD for rapid transition.
